



## Highway Maintenance Works • November 2023

### A39 Penryn Bypass

As part of our planned programme of works overnight road closures will be in place from Monday 6 November to Friday 10 November, to allow us to carry out routine maintenance activities. Work may include minor repairs, gully emptying, sign cleaning and vegetation control.

Works will be carried out at night between the hours of 7.00pm to 6.00am, prioritising times when traffic levels are low. As we work along the bypass, our maintenance activities will be carried out in phases to keep road closures within the locality as short as possible, to minimise disruption.

While the closures are in place, access for residents will be maintained. Bus services will also be given access through the closure sites, driving slowly to maintain a safe working environment for our teams. All through traffic will need to follow the diversions in place at all times.

Please be assured we will complete the works safely and as quickly as we can.

## Why are we doing this work?

We need to ensure Cornwall's highways network is maintained to safe and serviceable standard. Our routine maintenance includes minor works and cyclic activities such as gulley cleaning and sign repairs.

## Works area and diversions

Signs will be placed at major junctions prior to the road closure on the key routes to take non-through traffic away and keep traffic disruption to a minimum.

Diversion routes can sometimes be quite lengthy, but they have to be suitable for the type of traffic that would normally use the route. For safety, we need to put these measures in place.

Emergency access will be maintained at all times.

## Working safely

We encourage road users to follow the appropriate signage to ensure the safety of the workforce and fellow road users.
